#### PRAYER

**All Together Tuesday:** On the first Tuesday of every month we meet as a church to worship, pray and celebrate what is going on in our church and the wider community.

**Prayer Ministry:** After every Sunday service people are available to pray for anyone with needs, both great and small. An email Prayer Chain is maintained during the week to encourage prayer for emergencies that arise in the life of our congregation.

**Prayer Events:** We host periodic events to encourage prayer in our daily lives, such as workshops, retreats and healing services.

**Healing Prayer:** A group meets monthly for prayer for those in our congregation who are suffering emotionally, physically and/or spiritually. Members of the group are also available to pray with anyone individually.

#### GROWING OUR FAITH

**Home Groups:** Groups of all shapes and sizes meet on Tuesday nights (the majority) in various homes for food, prayer, study and chat. All are encouraged and welcome to join a group.

**Burning Man:** meets on alternate Thursdays from 7.00-8.00am (in term time). Bible teaching, fellowship and breakfast for men.

**Tuesday Women:** Bible study and discussion for the women of St Michael's to experience the dynamic relevance of the Bible in our lives today. 9.45-11.45am (in term-time). Crèche available.

**Community Bible Study for Women (CBS):** meets on Thursdays at 9.45am (in term time).

**Courses/Teaching Days:** Throughout the year we engage in courses such as Alpha, Marriage Preparation, The Marriage Course, Parenting, Leadership, Prayer and various topics brought to us by guest speakers.
